Six Locals To Play In U.P. All-Star Football Game

MARQUETTE -- Six local athletes have been selected to play in the U.P. Football All-Star Game at the Superior Dome on Saturday at 3 p.m. (EDT).

The game is traditionally East against West with the best seniors in the U.P. playing.

Ironwood's Mitch Kieber, Wakefield-Marenisco's Dallas Saubert, Ontonagon's Kyle Pollard and Ryan Moreau and Ewen-Trout Creek's Shane Johnson and Colin Ahlskog have been chosen.

Kieber was a special mention All-U.P. at tackle. Ahlskog was named to the All-U.P. Class D team at punter and was a special mention for Class D at quarterback and defensive back.

Johnson was named to the All-U.P. Class D team at defensive back. Moreau was a special mention for Class D at quarterback.

Saubert was a leader for the Cardinals football team in the four games they played this season. Pollard was a leader for the Gladiators in his final season.

All the proceeds for the event benefit the Beacon House, which is a place for families to stay while at Marquette General Hospital. Proceeds also go to the U.P. Sports Hall of Fame, Bay Cliff Health Camp and two individual U.P. schools.
