Malone to Help Ferzacca Coach All-Star Team

Negaunee-Members of the Negaunee recreation committee last night announced that Pat Malone, former Stambaugh football great who is now coaching at Green Bay West High School, will serve as assistant to Faust L. "Frosty" Ferzacca on the South team in the second annual Upper Peninsula All-Star football game to be played in Negaunee August 16.

Malone was known throughout the Peninsula for his football ability when playing with Stambaugh high school some years ago. For the past year he has been acting as assistant to Ferzacca in Green Bay. The West squad, under Ferzacca, has won all but two of its games in the last two years.

68 Candidates For Teams

Applications have been received from 68 players in the Peninsula. Fifty will ultimately be selected for the two squads. Many of the applicants are well known in Peninsula sports circles and include members of last year's all-Upper Peninsula team as well as one who received honorable mention on the all-state squad.

Mail orders for tickets will be accepted in about two weeks. Arrangements are being made for additional stands to handle the large crowd. Oral J. (Moose) LaCombe, director of the game, said some of the tickets would be held for sale at the gate, but the rest will be sold by mail order and at places in the Peninsula to be designated later.
