Park Falls Coach Will Aid Conley

Negaunee-John MacDonald, Park Falls, Wis., high school coach, has been named assistant coach of the "North" squad for the U.P. All-Star football game here August 14.

MacDonald was named by Harry T. Conley, Superior, Wis., coach selected to head the North coaching staff.

The assistant coach has built strong grid machines at Park Falls and his ability has brought him the respect of all Wisconsin Coaches. He is recreation director in Park Falls this summer.

Michigan Graduate

Conley, named early last week as the head North coach, was graduated from the University of Michigan in 1925 with a B.S. degree in physical education. He coached two years at Ellsworth College, Iowa Falls, Iowa, and one year at Duluth, Minn., before taking his present position at Superior's Central high.

During his years at Central, Conley put together a winning streak of 25 games in a row and during the last two years his teams have dropped but two games.

He served as basketball coach, also, until two years ago. His cage squads won the Wisconsin high school state tourney in 1935-36 and consolation title in 1937.
