Negaunee, Munising Place Three Players on All-Star Squad

Negaunee-The Upper Peninsula all star football squads have been named for the fourth annual game here Saturday night, Aug. 13.

Negaunee, Munising and Ironwood paced the selection in the North squad with three members each. Marquette, Sault St. Marie, Ishpeming, Wakefield and Calumet each have two players with single players coming from L'Anse, Hancock, Houghton, Newberry, Lake Linden and Ontonagon.

Six From Menominee

Six players were picked from the powerful Menominee team which is the number one for either squad. Iron River follows with four, Escanaba and Iron Mountain three each; Norway and Stambaugh, two; Manistique, Crystal Falls, Gladstone and Kingsford, one each.

Alfred Borsum, Newberry backfield star, led the balloting in the North and Escanaba's Warren Gustafson, one of the Upper Peninsula's most outstanding linemen, was the South's best vote getter.

The North line will average 176 pounds and the South will average 177 pounds. The difference in backfield weight will be even less than that. The South will have an average of 170.8 pounds and the North will have an average of 170.2 pounds.
