North's Assistant Mentor In All-Star Classic Holds Fine Record In Coaching

Negaunee-Bill Dessart, who has been named assistant coach of the North squad for the U.P. all-star football game has established a very impressive record in his 10 years of coaching. His football squads have won 76 games, lost only four and tied two. His best winning streak stretched to 39 contests.

Dessart will arrive here August 2 with Ward Cuff, coach at Catholic Central in Green Bay and head mentor for the North squad, to open training camp for the Northerners.

Graduate Of St. Norbert's

The assistant pilot, who is coach at Kewaunee, Wis., High School, is a graduate of West High School in Green Bay. During his prep career, Dessart played football, basketball and baseball.

He attended Conrad State College at Athens, W. Va., while serving in the Air Corps and later studied at the University of Wisconsin and St. Norbert's College in DePere, Wis., where he took his degree.

Dessart spent five years as assistant to Cuff at Catholic Central.
