### **Players On All-Star Grid Team Announced; Teams Report Next Week For Training**

Negaunee-Twelve players from Marquette, Baraga and Alger Counties were named to the North squad for the sixth annual Upper Peninsula All-Star Football Game, it was announced today.

They comprise nearly half of the 25 players chosen by the Peninsula's sportswriters and broadcasters to represent the North in the gridiron classic which will be played here Saturday night, August 11.

### **South 1950 Winners**

The South squad, winners of last year's contest, numbers 26 outstanding prep school graduates. Starting lineups for both squads will be chosen by the respective coaches-Ward Cuff, Green Bay, for the North and Mickey McCormick, Waukesha, Wisconsin.

Those named from Marquette County are Frank Young, end, Marquette; Neil Nystrom, tackle, Marquette; Melvin Holli, tackle, Ishpeming; Carl Lemin, back, Ishpeming; Bob Redman, back, Marquette, and Carl (Buck) Nystrom, back, Marquette.

Representing Baraga County will be Jerry May, end, Baraga; John Jestila, center, L'Anse, and Leslie Tollefson, back, L'Anse.

Alger County will send the following players, all of them from Munising: Douglas Miron, end; Richard Masters, center, and Art Gamelin, back.

All players will report here August 3 for an intensive training period. The coaching staffs are expected to arrive the preceding day. Cuff will be assisted by Bill Dessart, Kewaunee, Wisconsin. McCormick has not yet selected his assistant.
