Virginia Man Will Assist North Team

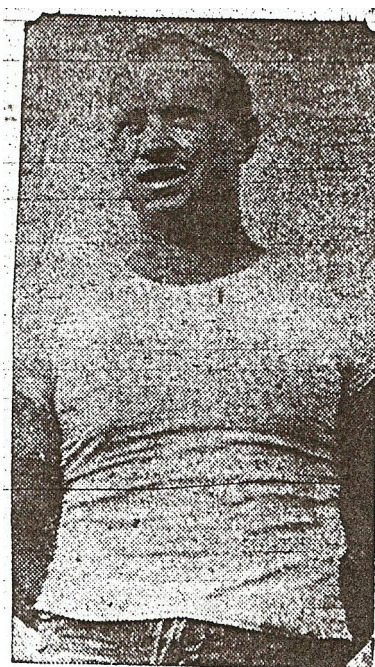
Played Four Years

Glod played four years of football at West Virginia Wesleyan College from 1939-42 period and was rated as an outstanding athlete. Entering service during the war he played three years at Keesler Field and one year in Honolulu.

After returning to the States, he was named head football coach at the Ohio college.

He received his master's degree in physical education this month and will start work on this doctor's degree this fall.

Victor Wojcihovski, head football coach at Mt. St. Joseph high school, Baltimore, Md., will be the South coach. He will be assisted by Stanley Zaleski, assistant coach at the same school.
