## **Tickets For Peninsula's All-Star Football Game In Negaunee Go On Sale: Mail Orders Also Being Accepted**

Tickets for the second annual Upper Peninsula all-star football game, to be played under the lights on the Playgrounds in Negaunee at 8:30 Saturday night, August 16, are on sale. It was announced today by Oral J. (Moose) LaCombe, Negaunee, director of the game.

Headquarters for the ticket sale will be the Levine Brothers Store, Iron Street, Negaunee. Reserved seat and general admission tickets, both of which have been placed on sale, may be obtained in person from Donald Levine at the store or by writing to him in Negaunee.

Mail order requests for tickets must be accompanied by a check or money order covering the total amount and a stamped, self-addressed envelope.

### **Where Tickets Are Sold**

Tickets also are being sold at eight other points in the Upper Peninsula, including three in Marquette County. Places where they may be purchased, and the number allotted to the seller, are as follows:

"There are approximately 2,300 reserved seats to be sold," LaCombe said, "and we expect this week's rush to practically exhaust that supply. For that reason, we are placing the general admission tickets on sale immediately."

"Numerous fans have inquired as to the general admission tickets, and have requested permission to purchase them ahead of time. By obtaining general admission tickets before the game, fans will not have to stand in line."

### **Bleachers From Ishpeming**

Seating capacity of the field was increased immensely with the addition of bleachers from Ishpeming. This will enable the Negaunee recreation committee to boost the seating capacity by approximately 1,000.

Wisconsin officials and coaches will handle the game. Faust L. Ferzacca, Iron Mountain native, now athletic director of Green Bay West High School, will mentor the South squad, and Arthur Krueger, former Marquette University All-American and present Marquette frosh coach, will coach the North delegation.
