**“SRO” Sign Dusted Off For U.P. All-Star Grid Contest**

Negaunee-Negaunee will observe V-J day Saturday, Aug. 14, with a day-long celebration beginning with a flag-raising ceremony and reaching a climax in the third annual Upper Peninsula all-star football game and fireworks display at night.

The fireworks display will take place on Teal Lake hill, overlooking the stadium immediately after the game. Football spectators will be able to remain in their seats and view the spectacle.

Sports, a parade and basket picnic at Jackson Park will round out the day.

A layout of 3,500 reserved seats will line the football field, leaving only the ends open for persons holding general admission tickets. This provides seating for 1,200 more persons than in former years.

The stadium and east side bleachers are sold out and it is expected the “standing room only sign” will be out before game time.
