U.P. Man To Be Honored at Grid Game

Negaunee-An Upper Peninsula person, who has made an outstanding contribution to U.P. sports, will be honored at the fifth all-star football game here Saturday night, Aug. 12.

The all-star committee, in making the announcement, said that a gift suitable to the recognition would be presented in a pre-game ceremony.

The recipient of the award for this year has been selected according to the committee, but his identity would not be disclosed until next week.

Active Booster

Edward Stevens, game director, said the person selected for the distinction is well-known throughout sport circles in the U.P and that he has been an active booster of all sports and good sportsmanship for a number of years.

“This man’s contributions to and interest in all sports has been so outstanding,” Stevens said, “that when a suggestion for such an award was made the committee was in full accord on his selection. We feel sure the public’s reaction will be the same when his name is announced.”

The committee did not say the award would be a feature of future all-star games.

Tickets for the game are on sale throughout the Upper Peninsula and the teams will report Saturday for the opening of practice.
