## **Sell-Out Crowd Assured For U.P. All-Star Football Game; Drill Sessions Nearing End**

Negaunee-A sell-out crowd is virtually certain for the Upper Peninsula All-Star Football Game Saturday night, according to members of the committee in charge of ticket sales.

They report reserved seat sales have been brisk in this area and in several other parts of the Upper Peninsula as well.

However, 1,000 reserved bleacher seats have been set aside and will be placed on sale at the stadium's main ticket office beginning at 9:30 a.m. Saturday. Committee members requested Marquette County fans to purchase reserved seat tickets during the day to help avoid congestion at the ticket windows immediately prior to game time. Tickets may be reserved until 5 p.m. Saturday by calling Negaunee 3, 1295 or 762-XR.

### **Plea Made To Residents**

Two thousand general admission tickets will go on sale at 6:30 p.m. Saturday at the stadium. Any reserved seat tickets which may be left over will be placed on sale at the same time.

In another effort to avoid congestion, Negaunee residents were urged not to drive their cars to the stadium. Parking facilities at the playgrounds area are expected to be taxed by the large number of out-of-town spectators, a spokesman said, adding that Negaunee citizens could ease the situation by walking to the game.

Kickoff will be at 8:30 p.m. and will be preceded by pre-game entertainment and flag-raising ceremonies.

Players on the North and South squads, meanwhile, were nearing the end of their nine-day practice period, with both teams reported in first rate condition. Observers who have followed the practice sessions each year say the squads are further advanced now than they have been at this stage of their training in any previous year.
