### **Kickoff In All-Star Football Battle Set for 8:30 Tomorrow**

Negaunee-Opening kickoff in the third Upper Peninsula all-star football game is scheduled for 8:30 tomorrow night in the Negaunee stadium and it will be broadcast by two radio stations—WJPD, Ishpeming, and WMAM, Marinette. Hill's Garage is sponsoring the broadcast by WJPD.

Halftime entertainment will be provided by the girls' drum corps of Escanaba and Miss Sharon Golden, Kaukauna, Wis., Wisconsin state baton twirling champion. Pre-game music will be played by the Negaunee city band.

Rain has not kept the two squads from the practice field and drills will be held under the lights tonight, as they were last night. Starting lineups are indefinite and all the boys are fighting for the opening spots.

### **Opening Ceremonies**

Ticket holders are requested to be in their seats by 8:20 for the opening ceremonies.

Dominic Olejniczak, mayor of Green Bay, Wis., will be a guest of Mayor Alvin Hampton and will participate in the opening ceremonies.

A limited number of reserved seats remain and may be obtained from Edward Stevens, city recreation director, at the city hall. They may be purchased at the stadium after the V-J day parade Saturday afternoon.
