Six County Gridders In North Lineup

Negaunee-Six Ishpeming, Marquette and Negaunee players have been assigned starting roles in the Upper Peninsula all-star game here tonight at 8:30.

The lineup was announced this noon by the North coaches, Russ Leksell of Rhineland, Wis., and Win Brockmeyer of Wausau, Wis.

Negaunee heads the list of probably starters with three players—Robert Jacka and Melvin Syrja in the line and Charles Leaf at quarterback. Jacka also was named captain of the North team.

Richard Aartila, end, and Richard Krieg, back, are the Marquette boys given probable starting assignments. Ishpeming's starter will be Eugene Dellangelo at fullback.

Sault Ste. Marie will have two starters, as will Munising. Hancock will have one in the starting eleven.
